Hereby constitutes and appoints XPO Global Forwarding, Inc. and XPO Customs Clearance Solutions, LLC, their affiliates and their respective officers, employees, and/or specifically authorized agents (each, "Grantee" or "XPO"), to act for and on its behalf as a true and lawful agent and attorney of Grantor for and in the name, place and stead of Grantor, from this date, in the United States (the "Territory") either in writing, electronically, or by other authorized means, to:

- Prepare and transmit electronic export information;
- Make, endorse, sign, declare, or swear to any withdrawal, declaration, certificate, bill of lading, carnet, shipper's export declaration, commercial invoice, insurance certificate, draft or any other document(s) required by law or regulation in connection with the exportation or transportation of any merchandise out or through the Territory, shipped or consigned by Grantor;
- Perform any act or condition which may be required by law or regulation in connection with such merchandise;
- Make endorsements on bills of lading conferring authority to transfer title; and to make, sign, declare, or swear to any statement supplemental statement, schedule, supplemental schedule, certificate of delivery, certificate of manufacture, certificate of manufacture and delivery, abstract of manufacturing records;
- Sign and swear to any document and to perform any act that may be necessary or required by law or regulation in connection with the entering, clearing, lading, unloading, or operation of any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by Grantor;
- Give to said agent and attorney full power and authority to do anything whatever requisite and necessary to be done in the Territory as fully as Grantor could do if present and acting hereby ratifying and confirming all that the said agent and attorney shall lawfully do by virtue of these presents.

Grantor, as exporter, hereby certifies that all statements and information contained in the documentation provided to Grantee relating to the exportation are true and correct. Furthermore, Grantor, as exporter, understands that civil and criminal penalties may be imposed for making false or fraudulent statements or for the violation of any United States laws or regulations on an export.

This power of attorney is to remain in full force and effect until revocation in writing is duly given and received by the Grantee; provided however, if the Grantor of this power of attorney is a partnership, then the period of this power of attorney shall not exceed two (2) years from the date of its execution at which time this power of attorney shall expire of its own accord and be without effect. If Grantor is a corporation, partnership, limited liability company, or similar entity, the signatory certifies that he/she has full authority to execute this on behalf of such Grantor.

Grantor understands and agrees that all transactions or services provided by XPO will be subject to and governed by the limitations of liability, time limits and other provisions of the XPO Standard Customer Terms and Conditions along with the terms of any applicable bills of lading, waybills, powers of attorney or other documents that are referenced therein (collectively, the "XPO Terms"), each of which are incorporated herein by reference. Grantor hereby acknowledges that it has received and reviewed the XPO Terms, which are available at www.xpo.com/business-terms or by emailing stc@xpo.com. For purposes of the XPO Terms, Grantor shall be the "Customer" and Grantee shall be the "Company."

I further certify that the SOLAS required VGM (verified Gross Mass) for each LCL and/or FCL shipment tendered by our company for shipment is true and correct and follows the strict guidelines set forth by SOLAS and the local authorities. I understand that any deviation from the supplied gross mass (weight) can result in my cargo not being loaded on board the vessel, and could result in fines and or storage charges.
